Get Involved!

Goal: Students will look at ways to get involved in high school. The objective is for students to go beyond what their FMPs or Teachers are involved with!

FMP/Teacher Introduction: FMP's will introduce themselves and share what clubs/sports they are involved with and how it has positively affected them.

Remember, colleges can only accommodate a finite number of athletes, but they can never have enough active, engaged students with leadership and community service experience.

Activity 1: In small groups have students make a list of clubs, activities, sports or groups they are einterested in involved in. Then have students share out.

Activity 2: Have students change groups and have them think of one thing they like to do and then have the group figure out what they could do at school that aligns with it. If the group gets stuck have the whole class help!

Activity 3: Have students create a list of ways they will become involved with and find a friend in class they can join with. Then have the students create a reminder to join / get more info.
